FOR I AM NOW READY

“For I am now ready to be offered, and the time of my departure is at hand. I have fought a good fight, I have finished my course, I have kept the faith: Henceforth there is laid up for me a crown of righteousness, which the Lord, the righteous judge, shall give me at that day: and not to me only, but unto all them also that love his appearing” (2 Tim. 4:6-8).

Paul is about to set sail for the bright shores of Immanuel’s Land. Paul likened his heavenly graduation to a drink offering poured out. The gradual ebbing away of Paul’s life was like the final pouring of the ceremonial drink offering. Paul’s life was truly a *“living sacrifice,”* and now his final imprisonment will be his last sacrificial act.

Paul then refers to his martyrdom as a departure, an unmooring of a ship that is scheduled to set sail on its final voyage. As Paul loosens the mental ropes of his gospel anchor, he gives Timothy a 3-point, grateful conclusion:

• I have fought a good fight:

- Though some called Paul mad (Acts 26:24), babblers (Acts 17:18), weak (2 Cor. 10:10), and loved him little (2 Cor. 12:15), Paul never lost his fight!

• I have finished my course:

- Perhaps it seems unfitting to the worldly mind for the Great Apostle to finish his God-given career in a filthy pit with only one friend by his side. But, did not our Savior pave the way? (John 17:4; Matt. 26:56)
- What a disciplined race Paul ran (1 Cor. 9:22-27): misunderstood by some, loved by others, and always pressing towards the mark!

• I have kept the faith:

- True to the Word of God, Paul always labored with *“Blood in the Basin.”* In deference to his dismal surroundings, the aged Paul stood as a snow-capped summit with confidence in his righteous Judge.

Paul stood before many unjust judges and unreason-

able brethren; but at the Bema Seat, Paul and all those who love the coming of Jesus will receive imperishable crowns.

Dear Servant of the Lord: Endure hardness as a good soldier of Jesus Christ. Keep striving to preach the gospel in order to advance the Kingdom of Christ (Rom. 15:20). And when the time of your departure arrives, **YOU’LL** be **READY!**
